Important! In the next week we will be asking parents and students to complete a short survey. The surveys are only 10 questions and this is part of our requirement from the state for accountability. This is an opportunity to inform us regarding your child's teacher. For K-2, parents will be asked to fill out the survey. For 3-8, students will fill out the survey. The survey will be available on line. All teachers are included – even *Specials* and *Special Ed*. We are looking for a 95% RESPONSE RATE. The URL is included today for the first round of grade level teachers. Thank-you in advance for your participation.

Just a reminder -

Assessment round. Students and staff alike have done an amazing job of troubleshooting "first-time" glitches and staying calm to complete the task at hand. Although the technology piece has been intense, the ease of actually administering the test and getting the responses uploaded as opposed to boxing 350 exams has been pretty painless. Congratulations to all as we wrap up this portion, and a special thanks to Aaron Peay, our super-human IT guy! He has put in many hours and been very responsive to our cries for help!

As you probably know, Spring Break will begin on Monday, March 30 and students return to school on Monday, April 6. The following week will be our Spring mid-term conferences. You should hear soon from your child's teacher regarding a schedule. Early release days will be April 15, 16, 17 - 1:00. Progress reports (Q3 report cards) will go home tomorrow.

Myths in the Media – There is a lot of talk about scheduling changes in the public schools, but at this point, please remember that these are APS changes and they do not affect NVA. We are already thinking about next year, and working on schedules but for the most part, our daily as well as annual schedule will look very similar to this past school year.

Some important pieces of information. It might seem small, but in the grand scheme of what we do these things are very important.

- 1. NVA is applying for a K-3+ grant. If we are awarded, it will mean that all incoming kindergarten through 3rd grade students will be eligible for 25 additional days of instruction beginning July 1. Also, we are trying to create a "3.5" group (a different source of funding) for incoming 4th graders that need a little more 3rd grade practice before they start their new school year. - 2. 4th and 7th grade students will take 3 sessions, on paper, of the SBA Science exam the week of April 6. Check with your teacher if this affects your child, and be conscious of appointments and missed days of school.




