(Research indicates that solid reading skills are the NUMBER 1 indicator to continued success in school).

Tomorrow will be the first Friday *focused instruction* block in the Middle School. Your middle school students will be receiving intense instruction, at their level, in both reading and math, taught by certified instructors, every Friday. This *is* a big deal, as it addressed our focus on academics and closing the gaps that exist for many of our students. This will be implemented in the 5th through kinder classes as well in a model that is appropriate to those students and classrooms.
