**Readers Raise the Roof** is tonight! At 5:00 p.m. enjoy complimentary pizza and from 5:30 – 6:30 kinder through 3<sup>rd</sup> grade families may enjoy a fun and activity filled presentation by our own Reading Interventionist, Jayma Reid and her “super crew” of literacy advocates. I heard a rumor that a teacher will be sawed in half! (No, not a principal...) Come join the fun as you, parents and guardians gain valuable insight into how children learn literacy skills and what you can do to support super readers! (*Research indicates that solid reading skills are the NUMBER 1 indicator to continued success in school*).

Tomorrow will be the first Friday *focused instruction* block in the Middle School. Your middle school students will be receiving intense instruction, at their level, in both reading and math, taught by certified instructors, every Friday. This *is* a big deal, as it addressed our focus on academics and closing the gaps that exist for many of our students. This will be implemented in the 5<sup>th</sup> through kinder classes as well in a model that is appropriate to those students and classrooms.
