If you can read it, you can sing it! North Valley Academy will be incorporating choral music as an auxiliary extension of our performing arts program.

This literacy based program is a classic, yet effective way to get kids excited about reading! One of the most stirring research revelations that has turned up in recent years, suggests that early exposure to music education can have a rather profound effect on a child's academics (namely in math and reading).
